

USAH Tournament Sanctioning

- 1. Prior to issuing any tournament permit (or tournament sanction), the requester, tournament promoter, and/or organizer will certify to Missouri Hockey (and the USAH District Referee-in Chief or his designee) that:**
 - a. Tournament playing rules are within USA Hockey guidelines.**
 - b. All on-ice Officials are currently members in good standing with USA Hockey and their home affiliate.**
 - c. All on-ice Officials are the recommended USA Hockey Officiating Program level or higher for the games to which they are assigned.**
 - d. All on-ice Officials are in compliance with USA Hockey and Missouri Hockey screening policies and procedures.**
 - e. The tournament has established reporting procedures that comply with the Central District Reporting Policy so the all reportable on or off ice incidents are reported to the proper Missouri Hockey and Central District officials within 24 hours of the incident – such procedures to be approved prior to the tournament by the Central District Referee-in-Chief or his designee.**

- 2. Prior to issuing any tournament permit (or tournament sanction), the requester, the tournament promoter, and/or organizer will provide Missouri Hockey with the financial disclosures required by the USA Hockey Annual Guide, Rules & Regulations, Section VIII (F), unless the tournament promoter/organizer is:**
 - a. A member organization of Missouri Hockey, or,**
 - b. An organization recognized by the Internal Revenue Service under IRC §503(c)(3).**
